Chief coach's report (Margo Wimberley)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • MW gave a review of the past year: • March 2014 Inter District Competition, Buckie: East district won both the skill level 1&2 competition and the skill level 3,4&5 competition. All the swimmers were from Edinburgh Synchro. Louise had individual success in skill 4&5 figures and Rachel was 2nd. Jennifer won skill 3 figures with Megan 2nd and Niamh was 3rd in skill 1&2 figures. • June 2014 Scottish Club Championships, Bellshill: The club had a good representation at the above championships. Louise won her solo event and the Edinburgh A team came 3rd in the combination team event. Edinburgh Synchro finished 3rd overall. • September 2014 Swimathon at the Royal Commonwealth Pool: The girls took part in a swimathon and raised a massive £590 which was split between the club and Scottish Autism. • October 2014 Scottish National Championships, Drumchapel: The club had three girls competing in the age groups. Jennifer came 3rd and Leah 4th in the national 13,14,15 category in both figures and solo. Niamh came 3rd in the national 12 and under figures. The Edinburgh A team competed in the open free combination team recreational event and came 3rd. • November 2014 Novice Competition, Bo'ness: 10 beginners from the club took part in the novice competition. Cale came 2nd in the figure event and Amelie and Laia came 3rd in the duets. • Individually the swimmers have continued to work towards their skill level assessments. Emma, Lauren, Niamh and Samantha passed skill 1. Aman, Emily, Maya and Niamh passed skill 2 and Leah passed skill 3. • Scottish Synchronised Swimmer of the Year 2014: This was won
