Terms explained:

- Competitive** A grade level is required to compete
Recreational No more than 50% of swimmers can meet the competitive requirement
Novice Those with no Grade or Grade 1
Age groups **12&under** Those born in 2008 - 2011
13-15 Those born in 2005 - 2007
Junior Those born in 2002 - 2004

Competitive team routine All swimmers should perform the routine together. A team must have between four and eight swimmers.

Combination team The routine is made up of a combination of routines (solos, duets, trios and teams). At least two parts must have fewer than three swimmers and at least two parts must have more than four swimmers. The team can have between four and ten swimmers.

Figure A prescribed element which the swimmer must perform once in front of the judges

Element A prescribed element from a technical routine which the swimmer must perform once in front of the judges
