



EDINBURGH SYNCHRONISED SWIMMING CLUB

COMPETITION FEES POLICY

- The club pays entry fees. Swimmers should notify coaches immediately if unable to attend any competitions. If swimmers have been entered for a competition and have to pull out, for whatever reason, they may be charged for their entry fee and/or any penalty charge that the competition organisers impose.
- Soloists and duets are responsible for organising their own routine costumes and hairpieces.
- Swimmers are required to pay for their food.

If the competition does not require an overnight stay the following applies:

- The club will levy a £10 competition fee per day for each competition that is not in Edinburgh. This will cover travel costs, preferred type of gelatine, hair pins and nets, and team routine costumes and hairpieces. This will be invoiced in advance of each competition and should be paid before the day of the competition.

If the competition requires an overnight stay the following applies:

- The club will organise travel and accommodation for volunteers and swimmers. This cost will be divided between the swimmers. This will be capped at £170 per swimmer for a two-night trip, and £90 per swimmer for a single-night trip. The club will pay for any remaining amount due.
- The fee will cover accommodation, travel costs, preferred type of gelatine, hair pins and nets, and team routine costumes and hairpieces. This will be invoiced in advance of each competition and should be paid before the day of the travel.
- There is a discount for the second swimmer from a family of £20.

Swimmers can pay in instalments and the club will encourage anyone who is having difficulty meeting the cost to contact the club to discuss this.
